	2009 Maryland General Assembly Session Brings Change for Employers
	The 2009 session of the Maryland General Assembly was an active one. Among the changes enacted were a clarification to the Flexible Leave Act and sweeping new requirements imposed upon the construction and landscaping industries' use of independent contractors. While neither bill has yet been signed by the Governor, both passed by wide margins and are likely to be signed.
