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Volume Cap Allocations Released for Recovery Zone Bonds

The American Recovery and Reinvestment Tax Act of 2009, enacted into law earlier this year, creates several new tax-exempt and tax-credit bond programs including Recovery Zone Facility Bonds and Recovery Zone Economic Development Bonds.

Recovery Zone Facility Bonds are a new category of tax-exempt private activity bond for use in areas designated by an issuer as a "recovery zone" (generally an area having significant poverty, unemployment or home-foreclosure rates as determined by the issuer). Proceeds of these bonds may be loaned to or otherwise used by private entities to finance privately owned facilities [click here for our April 2009 Public Finance alert on this topic].

Recovery Zone Economic Development Bonds are a new form of bond that pays the investor bondholder interest at a taxable rate. The issuer realizes the benefit of a tax-exempt rate by means of a direct payment from the U.S. Treasury to the issuer in an amount equal to 45% of each interest payment on the bonds. Proceeds of these bonds must be used by the issuer to finance governmental projects that promote economic development.

Both categories of recovery zone bonds can be issued only during 2009 and 2010 and are subject to aggregate volume caps of \$15 billion for Recovery Zone Facility Bonds and \$10 billion for Recovery Zone Economic Development Bonds. The allocations of the volume caps among the states and among jurisdictions subject to allocation within each state have just been issued by the U.S. Treasury [click here for Notice 2009-50]. Copies of the national and Maryland jurisdiction allocations are shown below.
